Dear Mr. Peoples:

On December 13, 2022, CRA International, Inc. d/b/a Charles River Associates filed Duquesne Light Company's (DLC) results of its DSP IX procurement process and rules for the December 2022 Solicitation for DLC's default service customers. The filing includes bid results for a Full Requirements RFP for the supply for medium commercial & industrial (C&I) customers who will receive default service from DLC within the period March 1, 2023, through May 31, 2023. This product was procured via the declining clock auction format.


This filing was submitted in accordance with the RFP Process and Rules that were approved as modified by the Commission's Order, entered January 14, 2021, at Docket No. P-2020-3019522. DLC requests that the Commission approve the bid results of the December 2022 Solicitation on or before December 14, 2022.

Further investigation does not appear to be warranted at this time, since the results of the December 2022 Solicitation appear to have been conducted in accordance with the RFP Process and Rules as approved by the Commission.
